Description:

The cost for the summer program will be \$300 for Varsity, JV, and Frosh. We need help from our Frosh/JV families for Varsity home games. If at least half of the families volunteer once, then we will not have an issue covering shifts. Every season the same volunteers can be seen at every game. They would also like to see their player take the field.

Players will be required to sign up by the coaches if we do not have enough coverage.

We would prefer not to do that, so please volunteer and help our Wolfpack family.

We have volunteer positions available for both snack bars. Time slots are broken down by the first half, with set up through half time & second half, with clean up after the game.

Members of the student body will help assist with the snack bar, set up & serve as runners.

Students are not allowed to handle money.

All student volunteers must have a WSB card & wear their Red Wave shirt for entry.

Students are to check in at the volunteer table. They do not need to enter through the Red Wave line. If your student would like to receive credit for volunteer hours, they need to bring their community service log. The person running their shift will sign off on their volunteer sheet by either someone at the cash box or an adult working with your student. If they do not check in and bring their log sheet, they **WILL NOT** receive credit for their hours.

For the first shift, all volunteers need to check in at the table by the main ticket booth to receive a wristband. You will be directed to which location you are working. If you are working the second half, check in will be at the main ticket booth. You will be provided with a wristband for entry, you can then report to your shift. If you receive a wristband and do not report for your shift, you will be asked to reschedule or pay for your ticket.

Our program's success is dependent upon volunteers.

All proceeds from the snack bar go **directly** to the football program. Ticket booth sales **do not**.
